Pulitzer Prize Winner *Three Tall Women* Opens at Langhorne Players

Newtown, PA, May 7, 2009 – Langhorne Players production of *Three Tall Women*, written by Edward Albee, opens on May 29 in the Spring Garden Mill, Newtown, PA. The play is the exploration of a women's life told in a most compelling and unique manner. It is equal parts lament and celebration filled with angst and humor. It's a simple enough premise, but Edward Albee, the old master of memory, invention, and self-presentation, builds on it to create a complex, discomfiting, and almost painfully fascinating multiple portrait. *Three Tall Women* was the winner of the 1994 Pulitzer Prize.
