

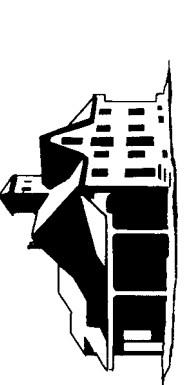

Written in 1929, *Rope* served as the basis for the 1948 Alfred Hitchcock classic film. For the mere sake of adventure, danger, and the "fun of the thing," Wyndham Brandon persuades his weak minded friend, Charles Granillo, to assist him in the murder of a fellow undergraduate, a perfectly harmless man named Ronald Raglan. Having packed the body away in a trunk positioned in the middle of their flat, they invite Ronald's father and a collection of friends to tea. With this all established in the first few minutes of the play, we are left to squirm in our seats as the tension gradually builds to the boiling point. *Rope* is a most interesting look back at manners and attitudes in the midst of the most bizarre circumstance.

## Langhorne Players

Langhorne Players' theater is housed in the historic Spring Garden Mill on the grounds of Tyler State Park in Newtown, PA. Audience members enjoy an intimate theater experience in the 73-seat, air-conditioned venue replete with comfortable, velvet-covered seats.

The lobby is transformed into a small art gallery for each show through our Community Outreach program where works of local artists are on display and available for sale. During intermission, patrons are treated to soft drinks and all-you-can-eat pretzels, potato chips, and cheese curls (our signature snack).

The Mill is west of Shir Ami Synagogue and Newtown Middle School at 1440 Newtown-Richboro Road (RT 332) and is accessible from the Newtown Bypass, Second Street Pike (RT 232) and Holland Road. The theater is wheel-chair accessible.
